# DAISY BOND STUDENT DESIGN awards

## AWARD CATEGORIES:

- ◇ DB01 - Commercial Design Concept
- ◇ DB02 - Residential Design Concept
- ◇ DB03 - Product Design
- ◇ DB04 - 3-D Visualization
- ◇ DB05 - Computer Generated Rendering
- ◇ DB06 - Hand-Drawn Rendering

## PRIZES:

- Best in Competition - \$1,500.00 + Trophy
- First Place - \$500.00 + trophy
- Second Place - Trophy
- Third Place - Trophy

## DEADLINES:

- All entries must be submitted no later than midnight June 16th

## RULES:

- The competition is open to full or part-time students in an interior design program in the State of Alabama, AND who are student members of ASID.
- Students may enter one project per category. Any single project can be entered in a maximum of two categories.
- First place entries may not be entered in this competition in future years.
- Entry forms that are missing information will be disqualified.
- The student's name is not to appear anywhere in the project submission. If anonymity is not preserved, the entry will be disqualified.

## PROCEDURES:

We're excited to be utilizing Design Awards Network and their amazing online system for our competitions this year.

To begin the entry process you will need to create your online account:

- Go to <https://designawards.network/#/>, under the column "Now Registering" click on the link for "ASID Alabama, Daisy Bond Student Design Awards 2018".
- You are now on the competition registration page that contains the competition rules and regulations. Scroll to the bottom under "Must Log In First" and click the link "create

an account” and follow the instructions. (You can go directly to the create and account page by clicking this link - <https://designawards.network/#/asidalabama/join>

- NOTE: Your account information can be your ASID log-in information or anything you can remember.
- Once you've created your log-in and registered. Click on the Now Registering ASID Alabama Daisy Bond Student Design Awards 2018. Once again you are on the competition registration page. At the bottom of this page is where you will select your entries by Category. \*\*You can come back again and select more entries later.
- The process of accessing your Entries is the same each time: Log-in, scroll down to Now Registering ASID Alabama link, click; in the Upper left corner of the page is Back to ASID Alabama where you'll see View Entry List. If you click on Entry Registration, this takes you back to purchase additional entries or view the chapter entry criteria, etc.
- You may continue to edit your entries until 11:59pm of the deadline date.
- The grey box at bottom of entry page is for publicity, not for judges' viewing. Here is your opportunity to tell the public about your project, write this towards the consumer instead of the judge.

## PLACEMENT and AWARDS:

- Entrants who place within the top three spots of each category will be notified via US mail.
- Final placement will be announced, and awards presented, at the Annual Awards Banquet in Birmingham on September 7, 2018.
- An entry must have a final average score of 11.00 out of 20.00 to place in the top three.

## EVALUATIONS:

- A jury of 5 practitioner interior designers and architects will review each entry.
- Entries will be judged on:
  - ◇ **Design objectives:** Clarity of project. Addresses project specifications and requirements as indicated in the project guidelines, parameters, challenges and objectives.
  - ◇ **Functionality:** Meets the project requirements and achieves functional objectives; *special attention to universal design considerations and sustainability where applicable.*

- ◇ **Design Creativity:** Originality. Creativity used in problem solving and design solutions. Creative use of materials, finishes, furnishings, and lighting.
- ◇ **Aesthetics:** Overall visual results of the project. Design principles and elements.
- All first place winning entries will be placed in the running for the *Best in Competition* award. The award will be presented to the project based upon the highest total score from all judges. In case of a tie, the ASID Alabama Board of Directors will choose the winning entry.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

All photos should be in .jpg, .jpeg, .png or .gif format, and must be 300 dpi or higher.

### I. Design Concept categories should include:

- Floorplan with FF&E
- Renderings of the completed project, to include at least 1 perspective drawing; no less than 2 photos, and no more than 4.
- At least 1 additional drawing; isometric, axonometric, elevation, etc.
- Any additional documentation needed to convey your design concept and solutions to the projects' challenges; can include digital presentation boards.

### II. Product Design category:

- Any documentation showing your creative process, such as inspiration photo or board.
- No less than 2 photos, and no more than 4.
- Initial sketches of your concept.
- Photos or renderings of the finished product.

### III. 3-D Visualization

- Submit only 1 project per entry.
- Floorplan with FF&E (.pdf format)
- No less than 2 photos, and no more than 4

### IV. Renderings (hand-drawn and computer generated)

- Submit only 1 project per entry.
- At least 1 photo is required, and no more than 2.
